The Planning Emergency Operations course provides an overview of operational planning concepts and procedures applicable to the emergency management profession. Participants develop a deep appreciation for the critical role planning plays in emergency preparedness and response. Learners in this course will become familiar with the *Comprehensive Preparedness Guides (CPG 101 and CPG 201)* to draft emergency plans following a six-step planning process that supports the Whole Community philosophy and to conduct a Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Analysis (THIRA). The course culminates with a special event planning case study where the concepts and procedures learned can be applied and evaluated.

EM Basic Academy Requirement: This is a required course in the Emergency Management Basic Academy.

Target Audience: This course is *highly recommended* for all emergency management and public safety professionals interested in developing a deeper understanding of the emergency operations planning process.
