This 1.5 day course is designed to inform and educate States, Locals, Tribes and Territories about the Public Assistance Delivery Model and Grants Portal. The course is designed to be a step-by-step approach, beginning with an overview of the PA Delivery Model Structure, followed by a walkthrough of each of the operational phases. Each unit identifies, defines, and discusses Recipient and Applicant specific roles, functions, and actions. In addition, the Recipients and Applicants will participate in hands-on training in the Public Assistance Grants Portal and other tools. At the conclusion of the course, Applicants and Recipients will receive valid user names and passwords to access the live Public Assistance Grants Portal. Through access to the live platform, stakeholders will be able to complete their Organizational Profiles and conduct preparation activities for future disaster declarations.

**Target Audience:** This course is recommended for emergency management professionals at the local, state and tribal levels who participate in the Public Assistance process.
