ICS 300 Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents

This 21-hour course is designed for front-line personnel with supervisory responsibilities to serve in a command or general staff position. The curriculum includes instruction in general principles associated with incident command, along with various tabletop exercises that allow students to put this knowledge to practical use. All students must have the Wi-Fi connection and the ability to view presentations and speakers to hear and speak in order to participate. We prefer camera operability for occasional use but it's not mandatory.
