ICS 400 Advanced ICS

This training is a 15-hour course that provides training on the advanced resource management provisions of the Incident Command System (ICS). Course topics include explaining the special management challenges of major incidents such as unified command, multi-agency coordination systems, and emergency operations centers, as well as explaining how Multi-Agency Coordination Systems (MACS) are established and interface with emergency operations centers. All students must have the Wi-Fi connection and the ability to view presentations and speakers to hear and speak in order to participate. We prefer camera operability for occasional use but it's not mandatory.

Applicants must document completion of all of the following prerequisites to be considered for enrollment. Successful completion of accredited versions of: IS 100, IS 200, IS 700, IS800 and ICS 300
